

A symposium held recently at the Abdus Salam International Centre for Theoretical Physics (ICTP), Trieste, marked the 70th birthday of distinguished theorist **Daniele Amati**. He left CERN 14 years ago to head the SISSA International Institute for Advanced Studies, which is adjacent to ICTP. Under his leadership, the institute is thriving, with research ranging from physics to biology and cognitive science. It is also the headquarters of the all-electronic *Journal of High-Energy Physics* (JHEP) – a pioneer in the field (*CERN Courier January* p19). The symposium reflected this broad interest.
